

Gentlemen:

Reference your Serial Letter H-0006 dated July 14, 2008, regarding your proposed additional superintendent on Contract W9126G-08-C-0004, ADAL Four Facilities, Laughlin AFB, Texas.

Specification section 01 45 04 Contractor Quality Control, defines the project superintendent as the highest level manager responsible for the overall construction activities at the site, including quality and production and must maintain a physical presence at the site at all times, except as otherwise acceptable to the Contracting Officer. This means the project superintendent is responsible for all construction and construction related activities at the site.

Contract Clause 52.236-6 SUPERINTENDENCE BY THE CONTRACTOR (APR 1984) states: "At all times during performance of this contract and until the work is completed and accepted, the Contractor shall directly superintend the work or assign and have on the worksite a competent superintendent who is satisfactory to the Contracting Officer and has authority to act for the Contractor."

The Government recognizes only one project superintendent per contract. Even though, this particular contract has four separate project sites, the contractor shall have only one project superintendent. You may supplement your project staff with competent qualified personnel to assist the project superintendent in effectively executing the contract. If it is your intent for Mr. David Smith to serve as an assistant to your project superintendent, Mr. Bobby Goodwin, please provide an organizational chart outlining duties and responsibilities.
